The clinic aims to assist women in making informed choices about how they want their baby to be born.

If you are planning a VBAC at BC Women's, you will be eligible to enter a study (RCT) on doula care (labour support) for women planning VBAC. Doulas will be assigned free of charge to 50% of the women planning VBAC.

Vaginal Birth After Cesarean

Giving birth vaginally after a previous cesarean birth can be a safe and good option for many women. This is known as a Vaginal Birth After Cesarean, or VBAC (pronounced VEE-back).

Research has shown that in many cases, VBAC can be a safe option for both mother and baby. Studies show that 70% to 80% of women who plan a VBAC will be successful at having a vaginal birth.

With VBAC, you can expect to spend less time in hospital and recover faster than you did with your cesarean birth.

However, VBAC is not recommended for every woman. It's important to know the benefits and risks of planning a VBAC compared to a cesarean before you choose either approach.

Making an appointment

The Best Birth Clinic schedules appointments with women who have had a previous cesarean birth and are at least 12 weeks into their current pregnancy.

Your doctor or midwife can refer you to the Best Birth Clinic, or you can call the clinic directly if you prefer. Women who live outside Vancouver are also welcome to book an appointment.
